1 Introduction

1.1 Mawson Primary School expects that students attending our school to wear school uniform at school as outlined by the ACT Department of Education and Training. This creates a sense of belonging and helps develop school pride. A school's dress standard plays an important role in promoting a positive image of the school. Full school uniform is required for school excursions and special events.

2 Rationale

The benefits of a school uniform include:

- Assisting students to learn the importance of appropriate presentation.
- Promoting the safety of students through easier identification
- Keeping costs of clothing within reasonable limits for parents
- Promoting a sense of a school identity and belonging among students

3. Schools Expectations

3.1 All students are expected to meet dress standards and uniform unless an exemption has been granted. Positive reinforcement and encouragement of school uniform will be encouraged by all staff. There are times, however, when family circumstances prevent students from wearing the school uniform. Teachers and school staff take these circumstances into consideration.

3.2 A student's inability to comply however should not interfere or interrupt student learning. Parents will be informed if a student is not wearing school uniform for an extended period of time and will work with the family to prevent a recurrence.

3.3 Financial hardship is managed discretely. The school will provide uniforms to families in these circumstances, through the student support funding provided by Department of Education and Training.

4 Uniform Types

4.1 All uniform items can be purchased through the school. Parents are encouraged to purchase the correct uniform from the school. The school uniform is outsourced to Noble Style. A sizing rack is kept on school grounds. Uniform order forms are returned to the school. All clothing can be picked up at the school.

5 Shoes

5.1 For safety, children should wear enclosed shoes, such as joggers, that allow easy mobility during physical activities and playtime. Such footwear as Crocs and thongs/flip-flops are not appropriate for school.

6 Sports Shirts

6.1 The school supplies a designated sports shirt for students who represent our school in inter-school events such as inter-school carnivals and games. There is no cost to students for using these shirts.

7 Year 6 Uniform

7.1 Each year our Year 6 students have the opportunity to purchase a special school shirt to wear. The shirt will be a short sleeved contrast panel polo shirt in royal blue and white. It is made with breezeway technology which draws moisture away from the body and enables air flow from the outside in. The shirt will have a screen print of the names of all the year 6 students on the back. There is also the opportunity to purchase a fleecy hooded jacket with the same screen print.
