Mawson Primary School is excited to be offering your child the opportunity to acquire essential life skills in water safety and survival through Royal Life Saving ACT.

The Royal Life Saving ACT *Swim and Survive* program runs over 2 weeks and is a series of 10 half hour practical lessons focussed on general water safety and personal aquatic survival skills. This targeted approach will ensure every participating student has the opportunity to access structured aquatic activities during primary school.

Please note: Only 98 places are available for students in Year 3-6. This year families will need to register online with payment for the program made at the time of registration only through Royal Lifesaving ACT.

IMPORTANT:	The online enrolment portal will automatically close 2 school days (closes Wednesday night at midnight) prior to our program start date. What to bring:	Swimmers, towel, and goggles (if they want) in a named bag. All items



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need to be labelled clearly with their name. A named plastic bag for wet items is also recommended.

Please note: *Students are expected to behave in accordance with school rules. Unacceptable behaviour may warrant the student being sent home at the expense of the parent/guardian. Staff accompanying students on excursion will take all reasonable care while the students are in their charge to protect them from injury and to control and supervise their behaviour and activities.*

Parents should be aware that staff members are not responsible for injuries or damage to property, which may occur on an excursion where, in all circumstances, the staff has not been negligent. Parents should warn children of the risk to themselves, to others and to property, of impulsive, willful or disobedient behaviour.

Attendance at this excursion is optional. Schools may offer or facilitate specific optional items, activities and services for which parents are required to pay if they want their child to access them. These excursions are classified as optional enrichment programs. If you do not wish your child to attend then a program will be available at the school.

Parents who wish their child to attend can pay the full amount within the given timeframe, or alternatively, make arrangements to make regular payments through an agreed payment plan. Cases of hardship should be referred to the Principal for confidential assessment.
