

2022 VOLUNTARY FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTIONS

Thank you to all families who paid voluntary contributions in 2021. Voluntary Contributions are an important source of funding for ACT public schools and enable the school to purchase many additional teaching resources that would not normally be able to be purchased.

In 2021, Mawson Primary School spent:

- \$6,700 on Mandarin resources
- \$8,565 on Maths resources
- \$16,126 on Literacy resources – guided and cooperative reading books, classroom libraries and library books
- \$9,409 on classroom resources



In 2021, 27% of families paid voluntary contributions and we raised \$35,909. To make these contributions affordable, the School Board has decided not to increase the cost of voluntary contributions. We hope this will encourage all families to contribute so that the school can purchase even more resources to support a rich learning environment for your child. We are hoping to receive \$40,000 in 2022. This will cover the cost of continuing to build our as STEM resources for our Digital Technology, curriculum and mathematics resources.

2022 Voluntary Financial Contributions have been set at:

Preschool - \$280 per student or \$70 per term

This contributes to the cost of resources provided in classrooms including, preschool class libraries, educational games and art and craft supplies.

K-6 - \$160 per student or \$40 per term

This contributes to the cost of class libraries, maths manipulatives and games, sport equipment and consumables.


In addition, students enrolled in the Mandarin Immersion Program (MIP) are asked to contribute an additional \$160 per year or \$40 per term.

This contributes to the cost of supporting the Mandarin program through developing class libraries in Mandarin, guided readers in Mandarin, Maths resources and games.

2022 Voluntary Contributions can also be paid into a Library Trust Fund. Donations to the Library Trust Fund are tax deductible and non-refundable. Please indicate LTF when depositing funds if you wish payments to be made into the Library Trust Fund.

The Education Act (2004) provides for the school board of a government school to ask parents of a child enrolled at the school, or anyone else, to make a voluntary financial contribution to the school. The regulatory principles state that: Each contribution is to be voluntary; A child at the school is not to be refused benefits or services because the child's parents do not make a contribution; A child is not to be harassed for contribution; Any record of contributions is confidential.
