The Education Act (2004) provides for the school board of a government school to ask parents of a child enrolled at the school, or anyone else, to make a voluntary financial contribution to the school. The regulatory principles state that: Each contribution is to be voluntary; A child at the school is not to be refused benefits or services because the child's parents do not make a contribution; A child is not to be harassed for contribution. Any record of contributions is confidential.
